INGREDIENTS:

| 1 quart fresh strawberries | 1 c powdered sugar |
| 1/2 c sugar | 1 (8 oz) container frozen whipped topping |
| 8 oz cream cheese, softened | 1 (14 oz) angel food cake (cut into cubes) |

DIRECTIONS:

1. Wash, stem, and cut strawberries in half. Add sugar, toss to mix well. Chill.
2. Beat cream cheese and powdered sugar well. Fold in whipped topping and cake cubes.
3. Spread cake mixture into an ungreased 13x9 dish. Cover and chill for at least 2 hours.
4. Cut cake into squares, top with strawberries.

What is it that you love and want to see in your garden? Is it picking fresh flowers for bouquets and enjoying the lush bounty of scents and colors? Do you enjoy looking out in your garden and feeling like you're close to nature? Is your garden a place for calm, quiet reflection? Is it a sanctuary from busy everyday life? Maybe your garden is good for a little of everything -- cut flowers, vegetables, entertaining -- as long as it all stays prim and proper! Perhaps it is a showplace for your collection of modern sculptures or other garden art. There's no right or wrong, only your style. Delve into what you want to see when you look out your windows each day. February is the perfect time to peruse gardening magazines, walk through nurseries, and see what's new on HGTV; it will give you the gratification that warmer weather is in sight. Give it a try. It will work, I promise!

What you need to do in the month of February

Home: Repair and paint window boxes, lawn furniture, tools, and other items in preparation for outdoor gardening and recreational use. Check out your local paint store, they have some amazing products with outstanding durability. And to keep our planet green, check out the low and even zero VOC paints available now.

Lawn: Raise your hand if you think an unkempt yard is unattractive... I agree! Not only can it be unsightly, but dense brush can be a potential fire hazard and can attract destructive creatures of all sorts. To keep your yard healthy, take an hour or two this weekend and clear out the brush you've allowed to grow unabashedly throughout the past year. This small task should help you get a jump start on your spring cleaning timetable.

Garden: Don't start your vegetable plants indoors too early. Six weeks ahead of the expected planting date is early enough for the fast growth species such as cabbage. Eight weeks allows enough time for the slower growing types such as peppers. Since we live in the 7/8 Hardiness Zone, typically the last freeze of the year happens around the end of April. A great rule of thumb for planting outdoors is to wait until Mother's Day weekend—because it always seems to snow that weekend...

And... Did you know that February 22nd is National Walk Your Dog Day? I see several dogs being walked every day, meandering through the neighborhood, sniffing this or that, enjoying their four legs and their keen sense of smell. Let's all mark this event on our calendar. It's a great opportunity to get to know your neighbors, and let the sun soak into your Vitamin D-deprived skin. See you out there!

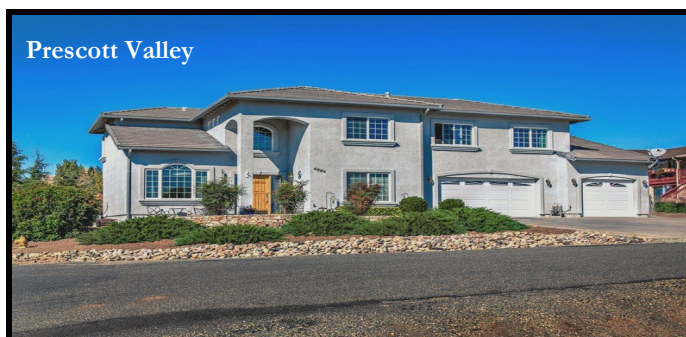

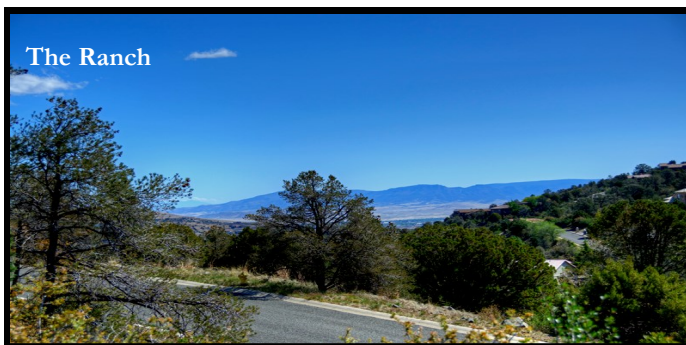
