

Pasta Primavera

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 bunch fresh basil
- 3 cups chicken broth, divided
- 1/2 cup olive oil
- 2 cloves garlic
- 1 lb fettuccine pasta
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 large leek, white and light
- green parts only, chopped
- 1 bunch green onions, chopped

(directions on next page)

- 2 jalapeno peppers, seeded & diced
- 2 pinches salt
- 2 zucchinis, diced
- 1 cup chopped sugar snap peas
- 1/2 shelled English peas
- 1 bunch asparagus, stalks diced, tips whole
- 1/2 cup grated parmesan cheese





Pasta Primavera (cont'd)

- Fill a large pot with lightly salted water and bring to a rolling boil. Hold basil bunch by the stems and dip basil leaves in the water until bright green, about 2 seconds. Immediately immerse the basil in ice water for several minutes until cold to stop the cooking process. Once the basil is cold, drain well. Remove basil leaves from stems and discard stems.
- 2. Blend basil leaves, 1 cup chicken broth, 1/2 cup olive oil, and garlic together in a blender until smooth.
- 3. Stir fettuccine into the same boiling water, bring back to a boil, and cook pasta over medium heat until cooked through but still firm to the bite (about 8 min)
- 4. Heat remaining 2 tablespoons olive oil in a large saucepan over medium heat. Cook and stir leek and green onion until softened, about 5 min. Add jalapeno and salt; cook and stir until jalapeno is soft, about 5 min.
- 5. Increase heat to medium-high. Stir 2 cups chicken broth, zucchini, sugar snap peas and English peas into jalapeno mixture; bring to a simmer and cook for 5 minutes. Add asparagus and continue cooking until asparagus is soft, about 3 minutes more.
- 6. Pour 1/4 cup basil/garlic mixture into zucchini mixture and cook and stir until heated through, about 1 minute. Remove from heat.
- 7. Place pasta in a large bowl; pour zucchini mixture over pasta and pour remaining basil-garlic mixture over the zucchini mixture. Spread parmesan cheese over the top. Toss mixture briefly to combine and tightly wrap bowl with aluminum foil. Let stand until past and vegetables soak up most of the juices and oil, about 5 minutes. Toss again and serve with crusty bread.

- Lawn: Do not over-fertilize! Many homeowners tend to throw down too much fertilizer at the first sign of green grass growth. In reality, the best thing to do is to apply a light amount of fertilizer in early spring, and then apply a larger dose a bit later in the season, after the initial growth rush.
- **Garden:** Starting or returning to your garden tending can not only add beauty to the outside of your home, but also brings color to the world, helps feed bees which are currently on the decline, and decrease carbon dioxide levels in the atmosphere. Making your garden a place that is comfortable, beautiful and eco-friendly makes for a happy world, a happy home, and a happy you. It's a must add to your spring to do list!


