Q: I would like to advertise my business on the bulletin board in the community center. May I do this?

A: The bulletin board in the community center should not be used for advertising, simply due to the lack of surface area. You can, however put a business card and a flyer in the community center. Bring your own holder, and ask the front desk where a good place to put them would be. If you have an event or would like to advertise something for sale, these temporary notices can be put on the bulletin board, but should be limited in size to a half sheet of paper.

Q: I read that the community parking rules state that street parking is not permitted in Stoneridge. However, I own five vehicles. Where am I supposed to park cars that don't fit in my driveway or garage?

A: It is true that street parking is not permitted in Stoneridge. It is also true that garages should not be used for storage but only for the parking of vehicles , which gives most residents space for four vehicles including the driveway. If you have used your garage and driveway for parking and still need more room, you will need to find a location off– site to store vehicles that will not fit in those areas.

Q: I would like more information on Block Watch. Is there a contact in Stoneridge?

From a Stoneridge Resident: When I come to a stop sign, I will actually <u>stop</u> and look in all directions before proceeding. There may be another car coming, people walking, or a child or animal darting into the street. While this is important at all intersections, it's particularly important at major intersections like Old Black Canyon Highway and Stoneridge Drive, and the Stoneridge Drive / Destiny / Lucky Draw intersection.

SESAME SHRIMP STIR-FRY

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 cups water
- 1 cup uncooked white rice
- 1 pound medium shrimp, peeled and deveined
- 1/4 teaspoon ground ginger
- 1/4 teaspoon cayenne pepper
- 1 clove garlic, minced •
- 1 tablespoon sesame seeds •
- 1/4 teaspoon ground black pepper •
- 2 tablespoons sesame oil •
- 1 red bell pepper, sliced into thin strips •
- 3 green onions, sliced •
- 3 tablespoons teriyaki sauce •
- 1/2 pound sugar snap peas
- 1/8 cup cornstarch •
- 3/4 cup chicken broth •
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1. In medium saucepan, bring salted water to a boil. Add rice, reduce heat, cover and simmer for 20 minutes.
- 2. While rice is simmering, combine shrimp, ginger, cayenne pepper, garlic, sesame seeds and black pepper in a large plastic food storage bag. Allow to marinate in the refrigerator.
- 3. Heat sesame oil in a large wok or skillet. Add red bell pepper and green onions; sauté 3 to 4 minutes to soften slightly. Add teriyaki sauce. Add peas and shrimp with seasoning; sauté 4 minutes or until shrimp are opaque.
- 4. Stir cornstarch into chicken broth and add to wok; cook stirring until mixture boils. Sprinkle with salt. Spoon shrimp mixture over rice.

- **Ingredients:**
- 1 sugar cube
- 6 mint leaves
- 2 oz. bourbon
- 1 oz. lime juice
- 1 oz. simple syrup 2 dashes absinth
- 3 dashes bitters, Angostura 3 dashes Peychaud's bitters
- 1 mint leaf for garnish

Directions:

Gently muddle sugar and mint in bourbon, lime, simple syrup and absinth. Dump into a Collins and add crushed ice. Dash bitters on top and swizzle lightly. Top with more crushed ice and mint garnish.
