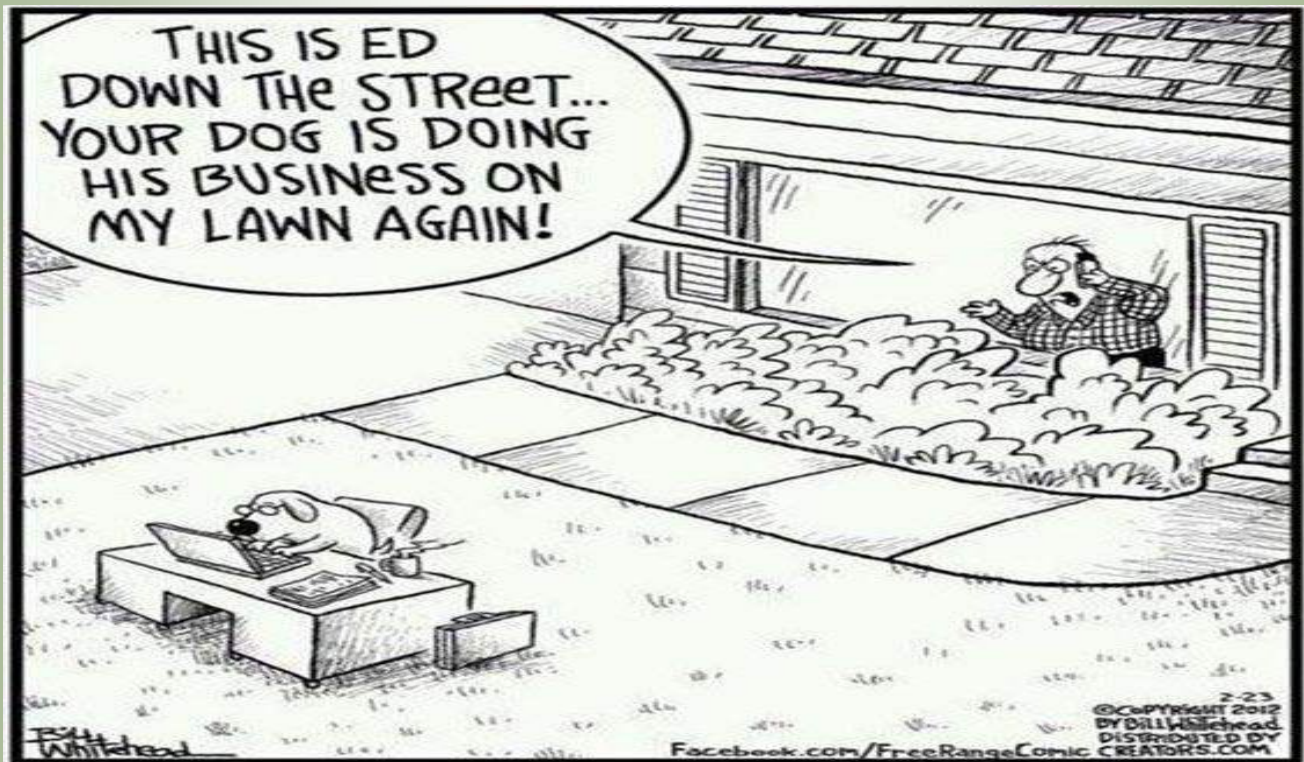

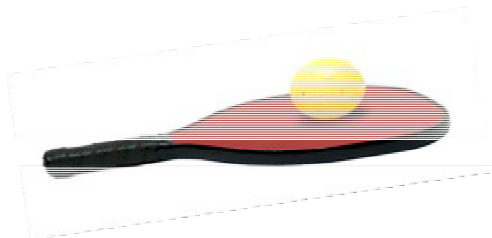

StoneRidge Yard Sale Tips....

1. **Preparation**– Start organizing, sorting, and pricing at least before the sale.
2. **Signage**– Post your signs and arrows where they can be easily seen by drivers.
3. **Pricing**– Pre-ticket all items to prevent haggling.
4. **Enlist help**– Putting on a yard sale can be labor intensive. Having family or friends to help man the cash box, run errands, and tag sold items is recommended.
5. **Stage the show**– Using tables, shelves, and clothing racks instead to the ground makes your items look more appealing.
6. **Put best items in plain sight**– Many shoppers will just drive by and if they see something appealing in the front there is a better chance they'll stop and shop!
7. **Cash**– Don't forget to have plenty one's, five's, and quarters in your cash box. Early morning customers often have \$20.00 bills.

Directions....."Healthy" No-Bake Chocolate-Peanut Butter

For the crust: Line an 8-inch square pan with foil so it overhangs on two sides and lightly coat with cooking spray. Process the cookies in a food processor until finely ground. Add the melted butter and process again until the crumbs are coated with the butter; add the melted chocolate and process until the mixture is the texture of very wet sand. Using an offset spatula, press the mixture into the bottom of the prepared pan, cover and refrigerate while preparing the filling. Clean out the food processor bowl.

For the filling and topping: Add the cream cheese, peanut butter, yogurt and sugar to the bowl of the food processor and process until smooth and combined. Pour the mixture over the crust and smooth with a spatula. Top with the peanuts and sprinkle with 1/4 teaspoon salt. Cover and refrigerate until set slightly looser than cream cheese, about 4 hours up to overnight.

Run a knife around the edges of the mixture to loosen, use the foil handles to lift it out, cut into 12 bars and serve chilled.

Crust:

- Cooking spray
- 24 chocolate wafer cookies
- 3 tablespoons unsalted butter, melted
- **4 ounces semisweet chocolate morsels, melted**

Filling: 4 ounces reduced-fat cream cheese

- 1/2 cup creamy all-natural peanut butter
- 1/2 cup 2-percent Greek yogurt
- **2/3 cup confectioners' sugar**

Top with nuts



Greek Yogurt Fruit Tart

Ingredients:

- 15 Medjool dates, soaked in warm water for 10 minutes¹
- 1 and 1/2 cups raw unsalted cashews²
- 1 cup Greek yogurt (I use vanilla, but any flavor works)
- assorted sliced fresh fruit

Directions:

1. Spray the bottom of a 9-inch tart or cake pan or a pie dish with nonstick spray and line the pan with parchment paper on top. Set aside. (The spray helps the parchment stick to the pan, making spreading the crust easier. The parchment prevents the crust from sticking to the pan. If you don't mind the taste of nonstick spray on the crust, you don't have to use parchment. Just spray the pan with the nonstick spray and add the crust.)
2. Make sure your dates are soft by soaking in warm water for 10 minutes. Make sure you drain them and chop in half before using.
3. Pulse the dates and cashews together until thick "dough" is formed and the cashews are all broken up, as pictured above. The dough will be moist from the oil in the nuts. Press evenly into prepared tart pan and partly up the sides.
4. Spread the yogurt on top of the crust. Decorate with fresh fruit. Slice, serve, enjoy.
5. **Make ahead tip:** The crust can be made 1-2 days in advance. Cover tightly and keep in the refrigerator until ready to serve. Continue with step 4. Store leftovers in the refrigerator.



Grilled Chicken Breasts with Spicy Peach Glaze

- 2 cups peach preserves or jam
- 3 tablespoons olive oil, plus more for brushing
- 2 tablespoons soy sauce
- 1 tablespoon Dijon mustard
- 1 tablespoon finely chopped garlic
- 1 small jalapeno, finely chopped
- Kosher salt and freshly ground pepper
- 8 frenched chicken breasts
- 4 ripe peaches, cut in half and pitted



Combine the peach preserves, olive oil, soy sauce, mustard, garlic and jalapeno in a medium bowl and season with salt and pepper. Reserve 1/2 cup.

Preheat the grill. Brush the chicken with olive oil and season with salt and pepper. Place the chicken skin-side down and cook until golden brown, 6 to 7 minutes. Turn over and continue cooking for 5 to 6 minutes. Brush both sides with the peach glaze and continue cooking until done, an additional 4 to 5 minutes.

Place the peach halves cut side down on the grill and grill for 2 minutes. Turn over, brush with the reserved 1/2 cup of peach glaze and grill until the peaches are soft, 3 to 4 more minutes.

Ingredients

- 225 g butter
- 30 ml prepared Dijon-style mustard
- 15 ml fresh lemon juice
- 8 g chopped garlic
- 4 g chopped fresh parsley
- 910 g medium raw shrimp, shelled, deveined, with tails attached



Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 450 degrees F (230 degrees C).
2. In a small saucepan over medium heat, combine the butter, mustard, lemon juice, garlic, and parsley. When the butter melts completely, remove from heat.
3. Arrange shrimp in a shallow baking dish. Pour the butter mixture over the shrimp.
4. Bake in preheated oven for 12 to 15 minutes or until the shrimp are pink and opaque.

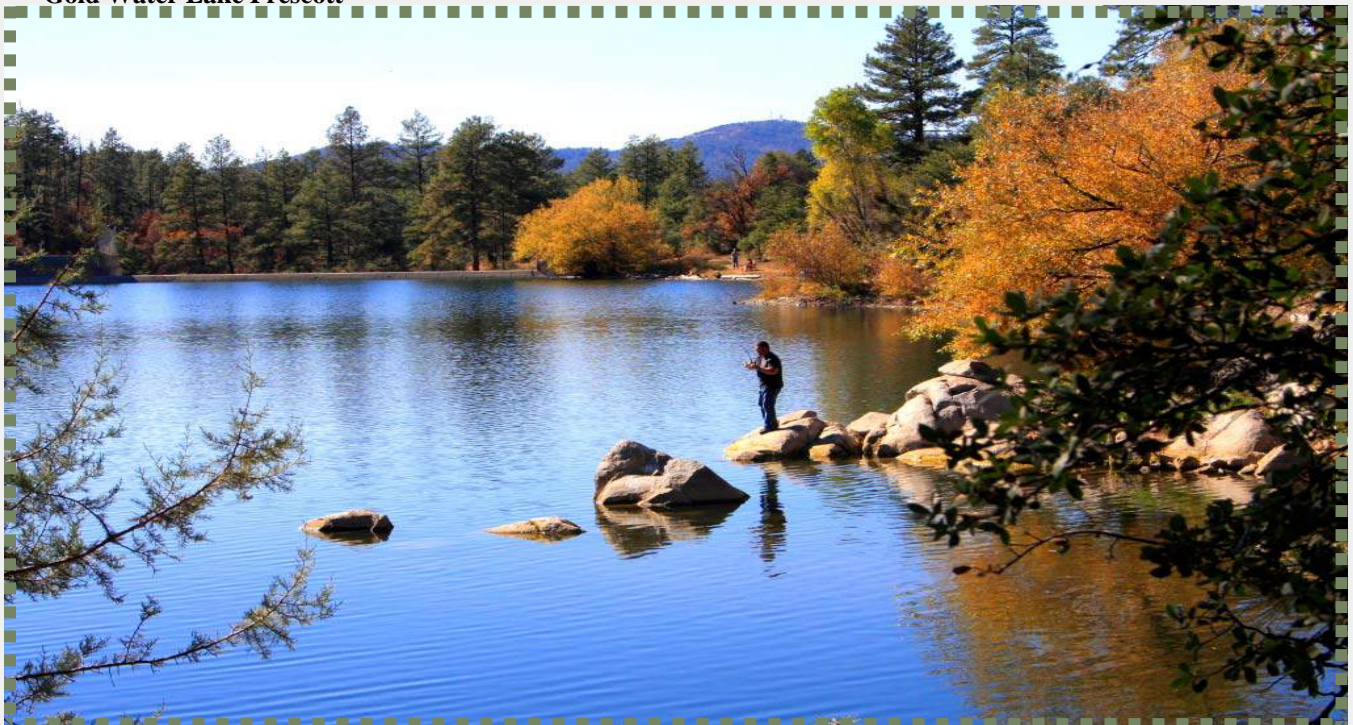
