



Remember the anticipation and dread of the first day back to school....

For many disadvantaged children and their parents the first day of school is a very anxious time. Will I have the supplies the teacher requires, will I have the money to start my children out on the right foot? Teachers in schools with a large population of low income students reach deep into their own pockets to make sure the classroom and all children get a good start. This year a coalition of non profit groups have combined their efforts to make sure that every child and teacher in the most disadvantaged areas start school with all the supplies required. Using economies of scale and bulk buying every child and every teacher will begin the school year with all the supplies needed for the year. Instead of spending \$80 per child this more efficient process will reduce costs to \$40.. For the first time each classroom will have exactly the items needed, for every child, and for every teacher and at half the cost of prior years. Would you think back to how it felt to have new crayons pencils and a cool new backpack to start the new school year? I hope you will take a moment to reach into your wallet and help us make this a reality for every child in need. The expectation is that after piloting this project, every child in our area will start school ready to succeed.



Stage 1 & 2 Fire Restrictions

The fire districts of Central Arizona Fire Medical Authority (which includes Prescott Valley, Chino Valley, Dewey-Humboldt, and unincorporated areas of Yavapai County) are currently under **Stage 1 & 2 fire restrictions**. This is in coordination the Prescott National Forest, the City of Prescott, and all of Yavapai County. Joint Press Release.

Stage 1 Restrictions:

- **NO** residential burn permits will be issued.
- Use of model rockets is **PROHIBITED**.
- Use of fireworks and other pyrotechnic displays are PROHIBITED except by commercial special events permit.
- NO smoking outside of vehicles, outside of residential yards, or outside of designated smoking areas.
- NO outdoor use of firearms.
- Cooking, warming, or camp fires (ash or ember producing) ARE still ALLOWED
 at single and multi-family residential properties and Town parks (where
 approved) but MUST BE attended at all times.

Stage 2 Restrictions:

- **NO** burn permits will be issued-residential or commercial.
- Use of model rockets is **PROHIBITED**.
- Use of **fireworks** and other pyrotechnic displays are **PROHIBITED** except by commercial special events permit.
- NO smoking outside of vehicles, outside of residential yards, or outside of designated smoking areas.
- **NO** outdoor use of firearms
- Welding, cutting and grinding is PROHIBITED (Permission may be granted under special circumstances and repair situations as approved by the Fire Marshal).**
- Chain saws are allowed with a spark arrestor, water or fire extinguisher and a fire watch.
- Warming fires, camp fires, as well as charcoal and wood burning barbecues (ember and ash producing) are **PROHIBITED** in all locations. This also **prohibits** the use of other devices that produce open flame such as tiki lamps.

The use of propane, natural gas or other gas flame-producing barbeque cooking grills or fire pits **MAY BE USED** as long as they are constantly attended, are in an enclosed device, and can be turned off.
